Volunteer Application Process

Volunteer Applicant

Community Volunteer or Parent

Will work with students in a district sponsored activity program

Obtain an Activity Supervisor clearance Certificate or clear a Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal background check prior to beginning the volunteer duties. (Ed. Code 49024)

May supervise students during lunch, breakfast, or other nutritional periods or may serve as nonteaching aides under the immediate supervision and direction of certificated personnel to perform noninstructional work which assists certificated personnel in the performance of teaching and administrative responsibilities.

District clears the potential volunteer through the Department of Justice Megan's Law web site.
